
Birth Register Dennis 1920

As a young man Dennis worked as a sales person in a shoes- and bootsshop in Leicester.

On the 24<sup>th</sup> of June, 1940, Dennis was twenty years old at the time, he enlisted in the army. His registration number shows that he was immediately placed with the Leicestershire Regiment.

In October of 1941, Dennis married Kathleen Mattock Potter in Leicester. Kathleen was born on the 4<sup>th</sup> of May, 1921 in Leicester. Her parents were John E. Mattock and Grace Margery Potter.


Kathleen worked in stockings factory Hosiery in Leicester. They lived on 145 Charnwood Street in Leicester. In September 1944 their daughter Regina M. Barker was born.




After the war, in July 1948, when Kathleen was 27 years old, she remarried Robert J. Horton, in Leicester, England. Her daughter Regina also got his last name, Horton. Kathleen and Robert had three more children together. On the 6<sup>th</sup> of December, 1994, Kathleen died at age 73 in Leicester.

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> of July, 1944, Dennis and the first battalion of the Leicestershire Regiment left for north eastern Europe to fight in WW2.

In August of 1944, Dennis was injured and returned to England on sick leave. He only rejoined his battalion in January 1945. On the 25<sup>th</sup> of March, 1945, Dennis was injured again during the battles in the area of Nijmegen. Sadly, his injuries were lethal this time, because on the 26<sup>th</sup> of March, 1945 Dennis Barker died as a result of his injuries.




